## **AWI RECAP**

March 21<sup>st</sup> was AWI night. The topic covered was SECTION 6 – MILLWORK. We went over definitions of exposed, semi-exposed & concealed surfaces (p. 148). It's not quite what you think. For example: semi-exposed refers to surfaces too high (greater than 80") or too low (less than 42") above the finished floor to see.

Overlap on edges (for panels & edging) are allowed...BUT it's different for custom vs. premium (p. 153). Chip-outs are allowed but for Premium they can't be visible more than 24 inches away (p.154). Over-machining of edges has a restriction too. Max of 1/32" every 72 inches. That is pretty limited. Custom is 1/32 every 48 inches (p. 154). There is also a spec for gaps in joints for assembled wood (p. 155) and for how it's to be fastened. Basically, if you can get the width of a tape measure in the void – it's too big.

We also got into closet shelving...so cool! (p. 153 & 159). Thickness vs. unsupported length (p. 153) needs a 2-inch edge OR be 1 inch thick. Gaps of up to 1/4 inch are allowed. Got gaps greater than 1/4 inch? They require edging. We decided to shoot for 1/8 inch all around.
